→Coral Bells "'Plum Pudding' Heuchera americana	*Ground cover with plum- purple evergreen foliage; white flowers in spring.	18 in. height	Moist, dry Ioam, sand	Part sun, Shade *Drought tolerant
Rough Goldenrod Solidago rugosa 'Fireworks'	*Yellow flower clusters bloom Aug. to Oct.	3 to 6.5 ft. height	Moist, dry Loam, sand.	Full/part sun *Drought tolerant
→Early Goldenrod Solidago juncea	*Yellow flower clusters June-Oct.	1 to 4 ft. height	Dry, moist sand	Full sun
Blue Mistflower Conclinium coelestinum	Fuzzy blue flower top red stems in Sept. and Oct.	2 to 3 ft. height 2 ft. width	Moist	Full/part sun
New England Aster Symphyotrichum novae-angliae	*Showy violet-purple flowers bloom in autumn.	1 to 6 ft .height	Moist Ioam	Full/part sun
Tufted creeping phlox 'Sherwood Purple' <i>Phlox stolonifera</i>	Mat forming ground cover with tiny, dense flower clusters in spring.	6 to 12 in. height	Moist Ioam	Part sun, Shade *Drought tolerant
Butterfly Weed Asclepias tuberosa	*Bright orange flowers in August-October attract adult butterflies, especially the Monarch; Monarch caterpillars feed on the plant (a type of milkweed).	1 to 3 ft. height	Dry to moist Loam, sand	Full/part sun *Drought tolerant once established.

Common Bearberry 'Massachusetts" Arcostaphyllos uvi-ursi	Evergreen goundcover with white blooms tinged with pink in April/May. Autumn red berries attract birds.	.5 to 1 ft. height Great for erosion control	Dry to moist, Well-drained sand and organic soils	Partial shade (under forest canopy) , full sun

Christmas Fern Polystichum acrostichoides	Evergreen fronds; fiddleheads in April.	2 to 3 ft. height	Moist Ioam, sand	Shade/part shade
Hay-scented Fern Dennstadia punctiloba	Provides wildlife cover/not attractive to rabbits.	1.5 to 2 ft. height	Moist, dry Humus, Ioam, sand	Shade/part shade
