### Refunds, Cancellations & Transfers

Effective June 1st, camp fees are non-refundable.

- Requests to withdraw from camp, made before June 1st, will be honored with a full refund if we can fill your child's spot, at the time of cancellation, with a child on the waiting list. If we cannot fill the spot at the time of cancellation, a cancellation fee of \$100 will be held. Effective June 1st, camp fees are non-refundable.
- Transfers will be accommodated as available. Two transfers, to another session, are permitted. Any additional transfers will be charged at \$35 administrative fee.

### **Photo Release**

• By checking "yes" to photo release during registration, you are giving us the right to use photos/videos of your child to support our mission. We also reserve the right to use participant artwork to support our mission.

#### **Camp Ages**

 To provide the best experience possible, campers must have completed the correct grade indicated for each camp, to participate. Campers who are not in the correct grade group will be canceled from the camp.

### How to Get On a Camp's Waitlist

• When searching camps on the Activities Calendar, you may see, after clicking on the camp, an alert saying the camp is full. In that alert, there is a link to fill out a form to get on the waitlist for that camp. Submit that form to get on our waitlist.

### Basic Policies for All Summer Camps

- Absence: If your child is not able to attend on a particular day, please let us know promptly so the camp is not delayed waiting for your child's arrival. See the Parents Corner for contact information for your camp site.
- Non-Parent Pick-Up: Add authorized pick-up people to your child's file during camp registration. After registration, authorized pick up people can be added through our front desk using the phone number below. IDs will be checked at pick up.
- Inclement Weather at Pick-Up: In case of heavy rain or thunderstorms please stay in your car until the storm abates. We will keep the campers in a safe, dry place during inclement weather and staff will then bring the campers out for pick up. Please note this may result in late pick up. Parents who cannot wait out the thunderstorm at pick up are welcome to pick up their child early before storms begin.
- Road Closures: During the summer, construction and road closures happen. We will do our best to alert you of these as we become aware of them. Updates will be posted on our website, Parents Corner, and the Homeroom App.
- Lunch & Snacks: Campers should bring water, lunch and snacks. If refrigeration is needed, campers will be asked to use an "Igloo" or similar personal lunch box with a cold pack. Water bottles can be refilled at the water fountain.
- All allergies (food or other), emotional, physical and behavioral exceptionalities, restrictions, or medical needs must be listed on your child's registration form, so that we can ensure they have a safe and

quality camp experience. The more we know about your child, the better we can make their experience. Feel free to call our camp staff to discuss your child's needs.

• **Sick Policy:** We ask parents to screen their child for illness before coming to camp each morning. If your child is showing any signs of illness, please keep them home. We will send children showing signs of illness home.

### **Drop Off & Pick Up**

• Drop off begins 10 min. before the camp start time. Pick up begins 10 min. before the camp end time.

### What to Bring

## Make sure everything is marked with your camper's name

- Day pack with water bottle, snacks, and lunch – packs will be stored in a classroom during the day
- A change of clothes and shoes (shoes get wet, it's best to have a dry pair to change in to)
- Non-aerosol Insect repellent
   and sunscreen
- Bathing suit and towel (Ashland camps only)
- Medication (labeled and in original packaging w/instructions)

#### **Medications**

 For Campers requiring medications at camp, parents must complete the medication administration form and turn it in to the camp staff with the medication. Medication must be in the original container. For prescription medication, we must follow the dosage instructions on the prescription. For over-the-counter medications, dosage may not exceed the label instructions. The medication administration form can be found on the parent's corner web page. Please send only enough medications for the week and be sure to pick up the bottle at the end of the camp session.

# PARENTS CORNER: GET READY FOR CAMP!

### What to Wear

- Clothes that can get muddy and worn in all kinds of weather.
- Hat
- Closed-toe shoes (old sneakers, or water shoes) – no flip flops or sandals
- Dress for the weather we go outside if it is raining

### Kayak, Canoe, & Paddling Camps

### What to Pack

- Lunch: Please pack in a waterproof container (like a dry bag)
- Water bottle
- Dry bag: We strongly suggest purchasing a 20-liter dry bag for your child to store and carry their lunch and belongings.

- Rain jacket if rain is in the forecast
- Towel
- Extra sunscreen/insect repellent

#### What to Wear

- Bathing suits or clothes that can get wet and dirty
- Closed-toe water shoes or sneakers that can get wet and that stay on
- Kayak gloves or a pair of good fitting garden gloves are optional, but they help prevent blisters and make hands more comfortable when paddling
- Hat (important for sun and insect protection)
- Sunglasses

### **Cooking Camps**

#### What to Pack & Wear

- Wear closed-toe shoes
- Have hair tied back/braided and not hanging down loosely
- Avoid wearing shirts with flowing sleeves
- Bring 1-2 smaller plastic dishes with tight-fitting lids for campers to take samples home for sharing
